FREEDOM OF INFORMATION – DECISION NOTICE

FOI Reference Number: 72124

I refer to your email of 11 December 2023 requesting information in relation to Key Worker Scheme contracts.

I can confirm on behalf of NHS Lincolnshire Integrated Care Board (ICB) and in accordance with S.1 (1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) that we do not hold the information that you have requested. Please see further details below:

I would be most grateful if you would provide me, under the Freedom of Information Act, details in respect to Key Worker Scheme contracts.

Key worker contracts have been developed as a response to the NHS England & NHS Improvement Long Term Plan (LTP) commitment that by 2023/24, children and young people with a learning disability, autism or both, with the most complex needs will have a designated Keyworker.

The details we require are:

- 1. What are the contractual performance KPI's for this contract?**
- 2. How was the contract commissioned? Please confirm if it was direct award or via a formal procurement process.**
- 3. Suppliers who applied for the contract and who were successful & not successful at the ITT stage.**
- 4. The supplier of the current service.**
- 5. Actual spend on this contract/framework (and any sub lots), from the start of the contract to the current date.**
- 6. Start date & duration of framework/contract?**
- 7. Could you please provide a copy of the service/product specification given to all bidders for when this contract was last advertised?**

8. **Is there an extension clause in the contract and, if so, the duration of the extension?**
9. **Has a decision been made yet on whether the contract is being either extended or renewed?**
10. **Who is the senior officer (outside of procurement) responsible for this contract?**
11. **Total contract award.**
This information is not held by the ICB. I would recommend you contact [Lincolnshire County Council](#) directly for the information you require.

I hope that this answers your queries with the information we currently hold, but if I can be of any further assistance please do not hesitate to contact me.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to
