You can join the event from anywhere, on any device – PC, smartphone or tablet -using a Chrome or Edge browser or through the Microsoft Teams app.


You can access the Annual Public Meeting by following this link on the day.

Did you know that people across Lincolnshire can benefit from Digital Health services?

HWLincs and Healthwatch Lincolnshire are working with NHS Lincolnshire to make you aware of digital health services that may be available to you at your local GP surgery.

Digital Health services are available across Lincolnshire. These are typically GP online services, similar to other online services, which provide a quick and easy platform to access medical records, order repeat prescriptions and make or cancel appointments from anywhere and at any time. They can also be used as a messaging system to your surgery during surgery opening hours.

These GP online services can be helpful if you want to reduce phone calls and/or travel to the surgery, and when you are juggling a busy life. They are accessible on smartphones, laptops and tablets, and are safe and secure, so that you have peace of mind that your data is protected.
