



# Mapping under doctored areas: the impact of medical training pathways on NHS workforce distribution and health inequalities


Access to healthcare relies on there being enough doctors to treat patients. There are fewer doctors in some areas, and it affects people's health because they cannot see a doctor when they need to. The problem of not having enough doctors is known as 'underdoctoring.' Areas that struggle to recruit

doctors often have other inequalities.

We want to understand the factors that affect where doctors work, including how this relates to their training, and these other inequalities.

Are you interested in our research? If so, there is an opportunity for you to participate in a Public and Patient Involvement Panel. If you are a patient, carer, family member or a community representative we want to hear your views.


