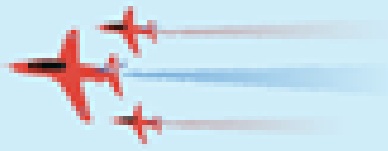

Norton Lea development - Lincolnshire Partnership NHS Foundation Trust (LPFT)

We want to improve privacy and dignity standards for people who use our services, so we'd like to create a sustainable 19-bed mixed gender mental health inpatient facility for working age adults at Norton Lea on London Road in Boston.

This project is part of a multi-million-pound investment to remove the outdated dormitory style accommodation, which we currently have at Pilgrim Hospital.

We hope by replacing Ward 12 onto the 5-acre site at Norton Lea, we will also be able to co-locate other mental health support services, including the crisis team, making it a real support hub for the people of Boston and the East Coast.

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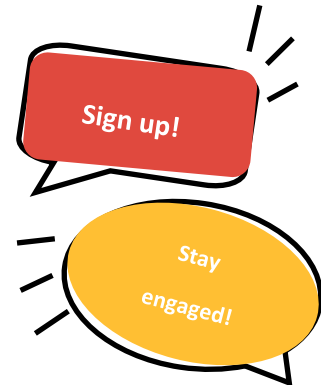
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
