

# Removing Patients from the Learning Disability Register following a Clinical Review

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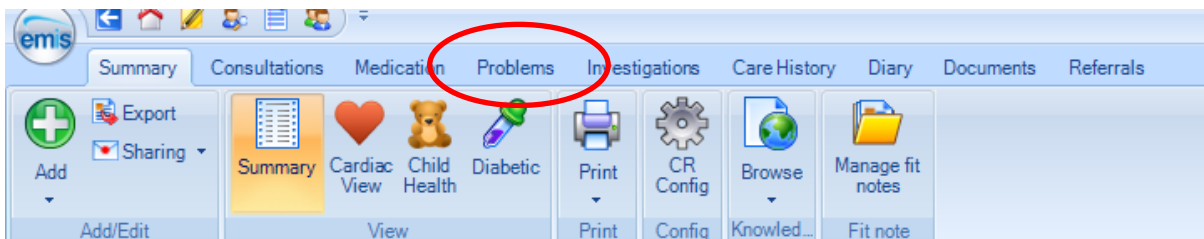
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## Clinical Review of Patients on the Learning Disability Register



## Finding all the Codes that have Triggered the LD Register in the Patients Record

Once in the patients record on the top menu bar click on the “**Problems**” tab



In the problems tab find the Learning Disability QOF codes
