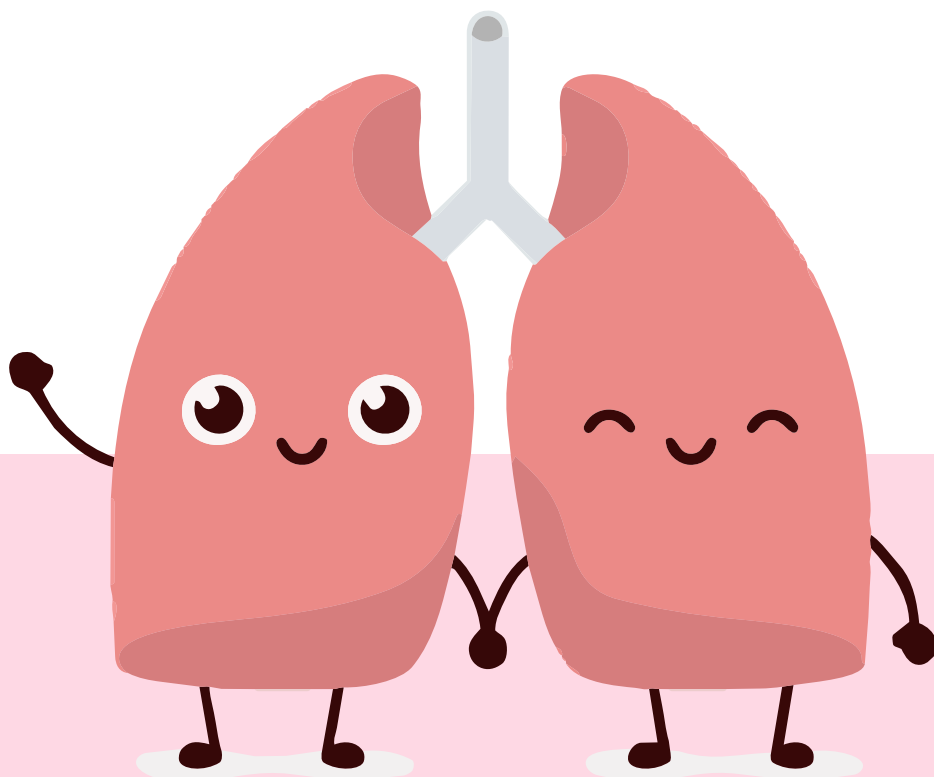

WHAT HAPPENS AFTER MY SCAN?

When can I expect my results?

Within four weeks of your scan, you will receive an outcome letter explaining what your CT scan showed. This will include information around what was found, what it means for you and next steps. A report of this finding will also be sent to your GP.

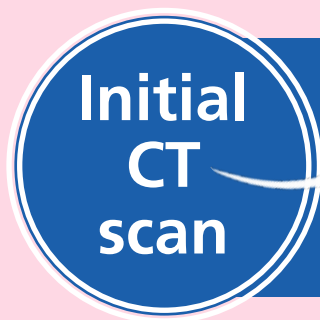
What are the possible outcomes?

If a minor nodule is found, you may be asked to return for further scans at 3 or 12 months.

If nothing significant is found, you will be asked to return for a further scan 24 months later to confirm all is well. Your outcome letter will acknowledge this, and you will receive a separate invitation letter to that follow-up scan nearer to the time.

This will look similar to the original letter you received, including details about the pre-booked appointment and how to change the appointment if needed.

In the unlikely case we find something that requires immediate action, we will contact you via telephone within a week of your scan.

Details for follow-up scan appointment will follow nearer to the time.

For 3-month scans, appointment details will be included in the letter.
