I can confirm that the Lincolnshire Health and Care Collaborative ceased to exist approximately 18 months ago.

Work has been taking place in recent months regarding the establishment of a Group arrangement between Lincolnshire Community Health Services NHS Trust (LCHS) and

United Lincolnshire Hospitals NHS Trust (ULHT). The formal arrangement will come into effect from 1st April 2024.

The new Group Chair is Mrs Elaine Baylis. The Group Chief Executive post is currently out to recruitment. No other senior posts have yet been recruited to.
