







People living with moderate to severe needs	1 st Step: Graduated response	Discuss your concerns/child's needs with your child's health visitor or education setting to agree a support plan that can be regularly reviewed and adapted. Also, speak to the Health Family Team or 0-19 Early Support Services for further help and advice. This process is often referred to as the graduated response. 16-18 year olds: If someone is under community paediatrics, they will have a shared care agreement with their GP. If they are transitioning across services or new to services, they will follow the adult pathway.
